WHAT IS INCLUDED IN THE 11+ ONLINE COURSE FOR YEAR 5?

- The SDE 11+ Online Course has been specifically created for Year 5 students in preparation for the GL Assessment 11+ tests, and comprises English, Verbal Reasoning, Maths and Non-Verbal Reasoning.
- Fully qualified and experienced teachers
 who are also a subject-area 11+ tutors.

WHEN ARE THE COURSES HELD?

The Year 5 11+ Online Course commences week beginning 13th October 2025 and finishes week ending 6th September 2026.

WHAT DOES THE ONLINE COURSE COVER?

The objective of all SDE 11+ Courses is to offer a first-class, quality Course where every effort is made to address the student's weaknesses, to maximise his/her examination performance and to extend each student to her/his fullest potential so the child has the best possible chance of success in the 11+. Everybody who works at Susan Daughtrey Education is striving for excellence and every possible effort is made to achieve it.

The Course is designed for a child who will benefit from lots of teacher contact, support and reinforcement and who will more ably cope with the subjects when spread over a longer period of time.

Interactive teacher-student group work in class to provide an engaging dynamic online environment and to practise and reinforce problem-solving skills. The teacher will often guide the students through several worked examples before the students get an opportunity to complete some further questions independently. The teacher will then provide the answers and review the more challenging questions with the class.



Initial Assessments (Weeks 1 and 2) the Online Course begins with initial assessments in English, Verbal Reasoning, Maths and Non-Verbal Reasoning.





A technique-focused approach to learning for the 11+ (Weeks 3 – 24, excluding 'Mini Mock' Weeks) - the Online Course concentrates on teaching every aspect of the English, Verbal Reasoning, Maths and Non-Verbal Reasoning components of the GL Assessment 11+ tests:

- Your child will be taught Susan's techniques to help her/him correctly and speedily approach GL Assessmentstyle verbal reasoning questions (including comprehension, cloze, proofreading, shuffled sentences and the '21 types' of verbal reasoning).
- The Maths component involves the teaching of the entire four-year Key Stage 2 Maths syllabus (which begins when the child is in Year 3 at school and concludes at the end of Year 6) as well as the application of Key Stage 2 Maths knowledge to 11+ style problem Maths questions.
- The techniques for all types of NVR question (including spatial reasoning) are taught as part of the Course.



Weekly Mini Tests - during weeks 3 – 24 progress tests in all subjects are taken in the first 10 – 12 minutes of each class. These 'Mini Tests' assess your child's vocabulary (which is set as part of the weekly homework assignment), verbal reasoning and/or Maths and in doing so not only provide additional weekly practice in all subjects, but fundamentally, assist the teacher to closely monitor the progress of each student.

SDE 11+ 'Mini Mocks' (held in early February and late March) are designed to:

- provide an early and gentle introduction to formal 11+ style exam testing; and
- help monitor each student's individual progress on the SDE 11+ Course.

The Mini Mock Sessions will be conducted during an online lesson under exam conditions and use multiple-choice test papers along with audio administration, similar to the final GL Assessment 11+ exams in many 11+ areas in England. Unlike the full SDE 11+ Mock Exams, which begin after Easter of Year 5, the Mini Mocks focus only on the subjects and topics covered on the SDE 11+ Course up to that point. Each Mini Mock serves as both a practice exam and a progress test, providing detailed feedback and analytics on the student's development.

GL Assessment-style 11+ Practice Tests

During the summer term (Weeks 25 to 30), students will take practice GL Assessment-style 11+ tests as part of their online class under exam conditions. These tests are designed to review and reinforce all the topics covered on the Course, familiarise students with the test format and procedures, and continue ongoing assessment. Written by Susan Daughtrey, these practice tests are separate from the SDE 11+ Mock Exam papers. After each test, there will be a review session to discuss the questions and ensure students understand the correct techniques.

As the lessons focus on reviewing the most difficult areas of the test papers, it may not allow for a full review of every question. To address this each of the five test papers are supplemented with Susan Daughtrey 11+ Dynamic Video Tuition®. These videos provide detailed explanations for every question answered incorrectly by your child and can be accessed by students and parents at home through their secure SDE Parent Login.

GL Assessment-style 11+ Mock Exams (In-person - Optional Extra)

- The 'full' SDE 11+ Mock Exams begin after Easter and are attended in addition to the regular weekly classes. Each 11+ Mock Exam Session is the equivalent of the real 11+ exam day.
- Available to those who require further exam practice, GL Assessment-style 11+ Mock Exams Sessions A G
 can be added as an optional extra at Registration. This option is highly recommended for those students
 who are intending to sit the real 11+ tests in September.





WHAT DOES MY CHILD NEED?

All students will need a computer, a screen, a webcam and a microphone (mobile phone screens are not suitable for online lessons), together with a fast broadband connection. The student should work at a desk/table and be sat on a fixed chair in a quiet room. Students must be supervised by someone over the age of 18 years old being present in the house during the online lesson.

WHAT IS THE ROLE OF PARENTS/CARERS?

The Online Course is demanding and requires significant effort, dedication and a positive attitude from your child. With these qualities, most parents report that their children enjoy the lessons, improve academically and develop strong study habits. Parents/carers are encouraged to play an active role in their child's learning, particularly by overseeing homework completion and using the provided 'Parent Homework Pack' to mark it.

SUMMER HOLIDAY HOMEWORK

Your child will be set summer holiday homework throughout the school summer holiday, to continue the practice and familiarisation of the subjects your child has learned. The final two lessons will take place shortly before the actual 11+ tests.

HOW MUCH DOES THE COURSE COST?

The total cost of the SDE 11+ Online Course, to include the cost of all online tuition, the four assessments, 2 Mini Mock Sessions, the Prep Bag of books and resources provided as part of the homework programme and online learning resources and results recording, is £2,880. The Prep Bag and resources will be posted half termly to any UK address (an additional fee applies for a non-UK address). The cost of the Course is payable in instalments, as follows:
