## PART 1

Read through the passage below and try to complete the passage using the sets of words from the Option Bank. You MUST NOT use any set of words from the Option Bank MORE THAN ONCE. The question number is written in the passage before the missing text and the letter you mark on the answer sheet is written beside each set of words in the Option Bank.

The *Bank Holidays Act 1871* provided that certain days throughout the year were official holidays (when banks and other offices were (1) *required by law to close* **E**). This change gave the population additional time for leisure activities like (2) *going to the beach* **B**. The speed of railway transport also meant that people could (3) *quickly travel* **C** to the seaside. Coastal towns like Blackpool, Cromer, Southend-on-Sea and Brighton quickly grew into popular (4) *holiday resorts* **A**.

The working classes were able to go to the beach on day trips from the factory towns. Wealthier folk went for longer periods of one or even two weeks during the summer, staying in (5) *hotels or guest houses* **D**.
